Welcome to Cullman, a city in north-Central Alabama that offers a slow and relaxed way of life with all the amenities of metropolitan living just a short drive away.

## THE HOSPITAL

Woodland Medical Center is a 100-bed, acute-care facility accredited by the Joint Commission and certified by the American Heart Association as a “Get with the Guidelines” facility. The hospital’s 70+ medical staff members represent a comprehensive range of specialties, including Cardiology, Emergency Medicine, ENT/Head & Neck Trauma, Family Practice, Gastroenterology, General Surgery, Internal Medicine, Orthopaedics/Orthopaedic

Surgery, Pathology, Pediatrics, Plastic Surgery, Podiatry, Psychiatry, Radiology, Rheumatology, Urgent Care, Urology and Vascular Surgery. The facility offers a full range of services, including 24-hour Emergency Care, Cardiopulmonary Care, Echocardiogram, Diabetes Education, Hematology, Inpatient Adult Psychiatric Unit, Lab, MRI, Mammography, Nuclear Medicine, Outpatient Surgery, Pain Management, Pediatric and Adult Orthopaedic Clinic, Physical Therapy, Sleep Studies, and Support Groups.

## THE COMMUNITY

Conveniently located near I-65 between two of Alabama’s largest cities – 45 minutes north of Birmingham and 45 minutes south of Huntsville – Cullman is the seat of government for one of Alabama’s fastest growing counties, with a school system and park system that rank among the best in the state.

Clarkson Covered Bridge is one of Alabama’s largest covered truss bridges and the site of the 1863 Battle of Hog Mountain. The bridge is the

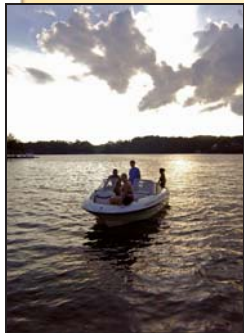
centerpiece of a park surrounded by picnic grounds and hiking trails. Ave Maria Grotto, known worldwide as “Jerusalem in Miniature,” was built on the site of Alabama’s first and only Benedictine Abbey. The three-acre site consists of more than 125 miniature reproductions of famous churches, shrines and buildings. Crooked Creek Civil War Museum, housed in a log cabin along the Forrest/Streight trail, features authentic Civil War memorabilia and a book of soldiers’ stories which paints a vivid picture of the battle. Evelyn Burrow Museum of Wallace State College includes thousands of rare items, some from the Smithsonian Institute.

## RECREATION

A few miles west of Cullman is the William Bankhead National Forest, 180,000 acres of pine and hardwood trees and home of the Sipsey Fork, Alabama’s only National Wild and Scenic River.

Cullman boasts an impressive city park system. Heritage Park is a 70-acre complex with baseball, softball and soccer fields, a children’s playground, walking trails, outdoor basketball and sand volleyball courts. Hurricane Creek Park is a registered Treasure Forest and features hiking and mountain biking trails, a swinging

bridge, waterfalls, hanging cliffs, shady picnic areas, primitive camp sites, rock climbing and Site: 32 on the North Alabama Birding Trail. Smith Lake has 500 miles of shoreline for camping, and 21,000 acres of clear water for fishing, skiing, and boating. Smith Lake Park offers 200+ tent and RV campsites, cabins, a swimming pool, spiral waterslide, lake swimming, picnic area, and special events throughout the summer. Sportsman Lake Park offers a small-scale train which runs along the shore, fishing, a mini-Ferris wheel and carousel, mini-golf, pedal boats, picnic area and paved trails for bikers, in-line skaters and walkers.



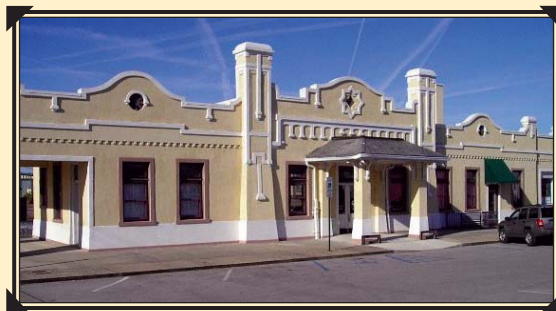
