Over \$1.4 Million In Capital Improvements

In next 18 months, we will complete a major interior renovation upgrade project. We have also added new equipment in our Imaging and Surgical Departments and made a number of quality improvements to our advanced facility including – Digital Mammography roll out, installation of Infant Security System, plus several equipment upgrades throughout the facility.

In fact, just last year, we invested over \$1.1 million in our facilities which, in addition to the above, included technology replacement, information technology additions/updates, and routine facility upkeep and maintenance.

Contributing To Our Local Tax Base

Last year, River Park Hospital paid over \$1.26 million in taxes which helped to support our city, county and state. This included sales taxes as well as property taxes. These dollars help to support local schools, development of roads, recruitment of business and industry, and other needed services.

Helping Those In Need

River Park Hospital provided over \$123 million in uncompensated care last year, which included the amounts not covered by government-sponsored programs such as Medicare and Medicaid. This amount also includes more than \$13.7.6 million for charity care, discounts for the uninsured, and bad debts, incurred as we cared for many people without sufficient resources.

Adding New Physicians

During the past year, River Park Hospital added two new physicians to our highly respected medical staff, including specialists in General Surgery and Orthopaedic Surgery.
