Capital Improvements

In 2010 we began preparing for major growth in the coming year. In fact, we invested over 408,000 in our facilities last year which, included technology replacement, information technology additions/updates, and routine facility upkeep and maintenance.

Contributing To Our Local Tax Base

Last year, Hartselle Medical Center paid over \$257,000 in taxes which helped to support our city, county and state. This included sales taxes as well as property taxes. These dollars help to support local schools, development of roads, recruitment of business and industry, and other needed services.

Helping Those In Need

Hartselle Medical Center provided over \$60.7 million in uncompensated care last year, which included the amounts not covered by government-sponsored programs such as Medicare and Medicaid. This amount also includes more than \$6.9 million for charity care, discounts for the uninsured, and bad debts, incurred as we cared for many people without sufficient resources.

Adding New Physicians

During the past year, Hartselle Medical Center added a Family physician to our highly respected medical staff: Bhavna Gowda, M.D., Family Practice. HMC also added a new hospitalist program under the direction of Dinesh Gandhi, M.D., Internal Medicine.
