Over \$1.4 Million In Capital Improvements

In 2010, NPMC purchased multiple pieces of advanced medical equipment and renovated areas to provide more comprehensive health care services to the area. Equipment purchased included the latest digital mammography technology, a Single Incision Laparoscope, Ventilators, Anesthesia Machines and an upgraded C-arm for the cardiac catheterization lab. We also made a number of quality improvements to our facility including the renovation of a new Center for Sleep Disorders, multiple waiting area remodels and a complete renovation of our cafeteria area.

In fact, we invested over \$1.4 million in our facilities last year which, in addition to the above, included technology replacement, information technology additions/updates, and routine facility upkeep and maintenance.

Contributing To Our Local Tax Base

Last year, National Park Medical Center paid over \$1.75 million in taxes which helped to support our city, county and state. This included sales taxes as well as property taxes. These dollars help to support local schools, development of roads, recruitment of business and industry, and other needed services.

Helping Those In Need

National Park Medical Center provided over \$348 million in uncompensated care last year, which included the amounts not covered by government-sponsored programs such as Medicare and Medicaid. This amount also includes more than \$32.6 million for charity care, discounts for the uninsured, and bad debts, incurred as we cared for many people without sufficient resources.

Adding New Physicians

During the past year, National Park Medical Center added eight new physicians to our highly respected medical staff, including specialists in family medicine, pulmonary care, emergency medicine, neurosurgery, oncology and obstetrics/gynecology. Our physician recruitment efforts continue to bring high quality physicians to the Hot Springs area, including interventional cardiologist, Eric Bowen, M.D., who joined us in January of this year.

One Of Our Community's Major Employers
